

Weekend / Static Camping Kit List

This list will help you pack for a static camp. There's far too much on this list if you're going hike-camping!

The most important thing is to make sure that you have sufficient clothes whatever the weather.

Don't forget that you will be doing activities that might entail getting wet and/or muddy, so plenty of extra clothing is advisable. A small supply of carrier bags will help you separate clean clothes from dirty ones.

Essential

- **Full Uniform** (which must be worn when arriving at and leaving the campsite)
- **Tent** - or at least make sure you know where you're sleeping!
- **Two completed copies of the Permission / Health Form**
- **Any medication you are currently taking**
- **A cake to share**
- the following, packed into a suitable rucksack or kit bag...

Bedding

- Teddy Bear (or other cuddly friend)
- Sleeping Bag
- Blanket (optional)
- Pillow (optional)
- Pyjamas / Tracksuit or similar to sleep in
- Carrimat (optional)
- Hot Water Bottle (optional - cold weather only)

Personal Wash Kit

- Towel(s)
- Flannel / Soap
- Toothbrush & paste
- Deodorant (think of your neighbours!)
- "Product" for your hair
- Any other stuff you *need* to use in the bathroom

Clothes

- Trousers / Shorts
- T-shirts
- Jumpers/sweatshirts
- plenty of socks
- Underwear
- Coat or Anorak
- Waterproofs
- Hat, scarf & gloves (optional - cold weather only)

Plate Bag

- Tea towel – not your Mum's best ones!
- Large Plastic/metal Plate (unbreakable)
- Plastic/metal Cereal Bowl (unbreakable)
- Plastic/metal Mug (unbreakable)
- Knife, Fork & Spoon
- Water bottle for carrying drinks
- Lunchbox (optional - for taking lunch offsite)

Footwear

- Trainers and/or strong shoes
- Wellingtons (very useful in wet weather!)
- Hiking boots if available

Activites

- Extra clothing / spare footwear
- Your own harness / wetsuit / helmet etc

Sundries

- Sun Hat / sun cream
- Torch and spare batteries / bulb
- Swimming costume
- Comic or book / small game
- Handkerchief
- Purse/wallet for any money
- daysack (for spare clothes/lunch while offsite)
- Personal First Aid Kit (optional)

REMEMBER: JEANS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR WATER ACTIVITES OR HIKING.

There is no need to bring....

Mobile phones, MP3 players, electronic games, tarot cards, chocolates and sweets – unless they are presents for your Leaders – hunting knives, saws, axes, matches, flammable liquids etc***So please don't!***
